To the ground floor there is 2 further bedrooms, bathroom with full bath.

This amazing property is very spacious with its open plan quality custom made kitchen/ lounge and dining room with feature archway, fireplace and has been constructed with high quality internally and externally. There is a BBQ area tucked away in the grounds, a lagoon style swimming pool with ample of sunbathing terrace.

To the front and rear of the villa there is some lovely wooden terraces with plenty of shade and perfect for those lovely summer evenings. In addition the property benefits olive and almond groves and a large carport.

This is a property with excellent access and is a complete hidden gem, viewing highly recommended.

Aspe town is located in the valley of the river Vinalopó, . It is a charming town, in a rural area surrounded by mountains, vines, olives and almonds but it is also just a few minutes' drive from the bustling cities of Elche (12 km) and Alicante (25 km). Alicante airport and Costa Blanca's beaches are just 22 km away. The economy of Aspe is based on textile and footwear industries, as well as farming. Aspe is also famous for growing a special kind of grape, which is traditionally eaten at the stroke of midnight, every New Year's Eve, all across Spain.

Places to visit include the historical centre (casco antiguo), Basilica of Nuestra Señora del Socorro (founded in 1602), Town Hall (17th century), Castillo del Río, a walled settlements located 4 km outside the town and the Municipal Historical Museum.

Fiesta de la Virgen de las Nieves, is celebrated from 3rd August, every other year the fiesta takes place in the neighbouring village of Hondón de las Nieves
